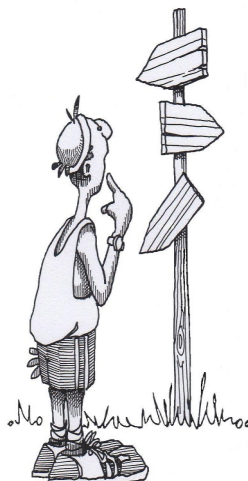


IMAGE Youth Choir and Orchestra began Sunday, Sept. 11 at 4:15 and 5:15 PM respectively.
