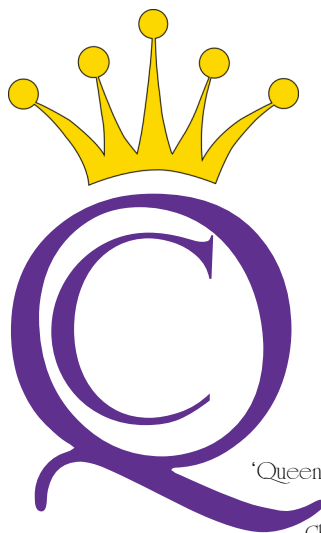

Our men's quartet, Dominion, has recently returned from Nashville, TN on the first of three trips to work on their new CD recording project. Let me encourage you to take a moment and ask Marty, Randy, Rob or Joe about the fast and furious experience.... you'll quickly learn by their fully dilated eyes, rapid speech, and animated gestures that it was an incredible, jaw-dropping, truly unforgettable experience!

The recording studio they worked in is located on the campus of the Trinity Broadcasting Network and is totally state of the art. The 40-year veteran engineer and highly seasoned session musicians were all creative professionals who gave everything they had to the musical moment. (Many of the players laying down the tracks actually recorded the original Gaither CDs, as well as other groups' music Dominion is recording.) The charts the arrangers wrote just for the project create a fresh, new sound for the group, and include a couple up-dated "old favorites" with new energy and listening beauty.

Please continue to remember Marty, Randy, Rob, Joe, and each of their families in your prayers as the group continues to rehearse on Sunday evenings and then travel back and forth to "Music City" the weekends of May 26 and June 2.
