Barnabas Foundation. Here is a summary of the  
work of this organization, and how Reverend  
Cook became involved:

It was the day that I met Dixie Sanchez. I saw her  
walking around and noticed “2/12” marked on her  
hand. She was two years old and weighed only  
twelve pounds. I knelt to hold her hand and still  
towered over her tiny frame. Who would have  
thought that this little girl would have inspired so  
much to happen in the next eight years? With  
Dixie as my muse and the gifts of faithful  
supporters, the *Friends of Barnabas Foundation*  
has changed so many lives.

FOBF has:

- Provided free medical care to 186,236 children  
and adults,
- Provided 20,576 pairs of eyeglasses to those in  
need,
- Sent 1,134 individual missionaries on 82 mountain  
medical mission teams,
- Sent 308 surgeons, nurses, and support staff on  
surgical mission teams,
- Provided 738 life-saving and life-changing  
surgeries for children,
- Cared for over 24,000 children and adults at the  
Barnabas House Clinic,
- Given away over 6,000 Spanish Bibles to  
mountain clinic families.

One little girl, whose hand I held for a few short  
moments, has changed so many lives in her  
country. I knew in that moment that I had to make  
a difference and that I could make a difference.
